PHYTOPHTHORA INFESTANS



The potato late blight pathogen was introduced to Europe in the 1840s and caused the loss of a staple crop, leading to the Irish potato famine.

Currently the plant pathogen that has most greatly impacted humanity and remains a major threat to food security.

Migration estimates using microsatellite variation support a new theory of originating from central Mexico rather than the previously believed Andes Mountains through commercial potato seed trade.


