



# Weekly Wisdom: Seasonal Viruses and Illnesses



#### The Flu

The flu season lasts from October through May. It is caused by influenza viruses. Symptoms include sudden fatigue, sore throat, fever, headache, and chills



#### The Common Cold

Colds can be caused by a number of different viruses, such as rhinoviruses and parainfluenza. Symptoms are similar to the Flu, but are more mild



#### **Sore Throats**

Are commonly caused by viral infections, such as colds and the flu. They can persist after the cold or flu has subsided



## Seasonal Allergies

Seasonal allergies create symptoms similar to being sick, including runny or stuffy nose, sneezing, headache, and watery eyes.



### Weekly Wisdom: Seasonal Viruses and Illnesses

#### The Flu vs The Common Cold

- It is difficult to distinguish between the flu and the common cold due to the similar symptoms
- The flu is more intense and begins more abruptly
- People with the common cold are more likely to have stuffy or runny noses



#### **Preventions**

- Get vaccinated for the flu!
- Wash your hands often
- 3. Avoid crowded places
- Get plenty of rest and maintain a healthy diet
